

2020 ROCKY MOUNTAIN CHAPTER AMERICAN CONCRETE INSTITUTE *JEAN-CLAUDE ROUMAIN MEMORIAL* SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

The Rocky Mountain Chapter of the American Concrete Institute Jean-Claude Roumain Memorial Scholarship is a one-time \$1500 grant offered to an Engineering or Construction Management student who shows an interest in concrete as a sustainable construction medium. Deadline for application is December 4, 2020.

Eligibility requirements:

1. Any currently enrolled undergraduate or graduate level engineering or construction management student residing in Colorado or Wyoming during the academic year.
2. Must be Student Member of the Rocky Mountain Chapter of ACI. Membership is free and membership application can be completed online prior to submitting Scholarship Application. See page 3 for details.
3. The Scholarship may be awarded only to those students who will use it for their official undergraduate or graduate level education at an ABET accredited educational establishment.

Applications must include all of the following information submitted electronically by December 4, 2020:

- Completed application form submitted electronically (below on page 2).
- Personal essay which shall be no less than 1000 words and no more than 1500 words.

How will the scholarship be used toward your engineering and/or construction management degree?

What do you see as an important area for research and development for advancement of concrete as a sustainable construction material?

- One official electronic transcript. Graduate students shall submit both undergraduate and graduate transcripts.
- Resume
- Scholarship will be awarded at the Rocky Mountain Chapter ACI – Annual Meeting in December

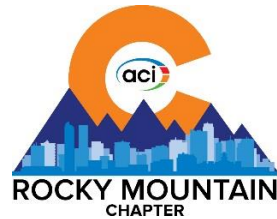
