ABOUT JEAN-CLAUDE ROUMAIN

Jean-Claude Roumain, FACI, was a sustainable concrete activist and enthusiast. He was known locally within the Rocky Mountain Chapter ACI and was internationally recognized in the broader cement industry. His sustainability efforts began around 2007 and were decades ahead of his time. J.C. was a world-renowned speaker who realized the value of education and how critical it is for success. He had the gift of communication and was able to relate to people at all levels. Whether it's the finisher holding a concrete trowel for the first time in the field, a seasoned engineer, a top executive, or a government official, he was able to share his knowledge. He was often quoted as saying "the future is now!". His groundbreaking work in sustainability lives on today through the many people he mentored and inspired. This scholarship was created in his memory, to inspire future generations in the exploration of sustainable concrete construction and materials.

SCHOLARSHIP AWARD

The Rocky Mountain Chapter of the American Concrete Institute's Jean-Claude Roumain Memorial Scholarship will award a one-time grant of \$2,000 to an Engineering or Construction Management student who shows an interest in concrete as a sustainable construction medium. The scholarship will be awarded at the Rocky Mountain Chapter ACI Annual Meeting in December.

The scholarship may be awarded only to students who will use it for their official undergraduate or graduate level education at an ABET accredited educational establishment.

1. Must be currently enrolled as an undergraduate or graduate student in an Engineering or Construction Management program who resides in Colorado or Wyoming.

- **Signed Application Form**
- **Essay Question** (500 Word Limit)
- **Short Answer Question** (200 Word Limit)
- **Transcript** - Official copy of most recent university transcript. (Graduate students submit undergrad and graduate transcripts.)
- **Resume** - Relevant work experience, internships, memberships, and extracurricular activities
